## Prepare for Severe Winter Weather — **PLEASE AND STAY SAFE!**

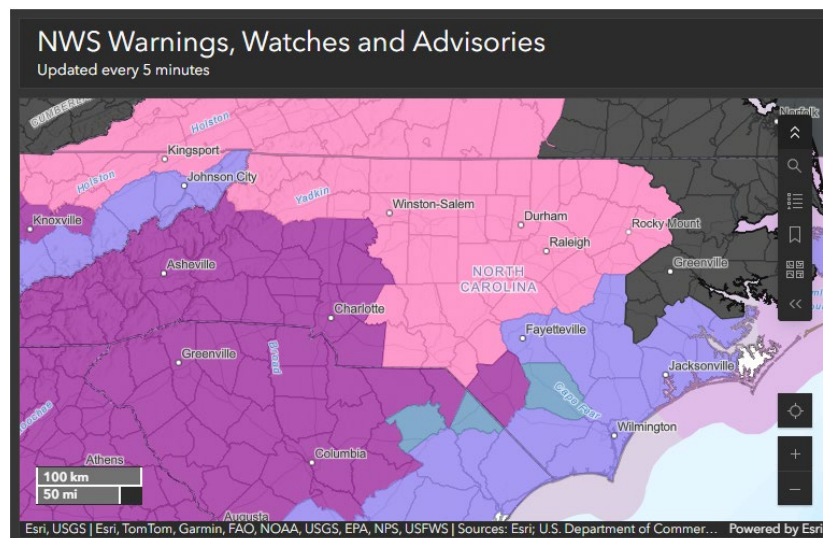


Good day, Friends,

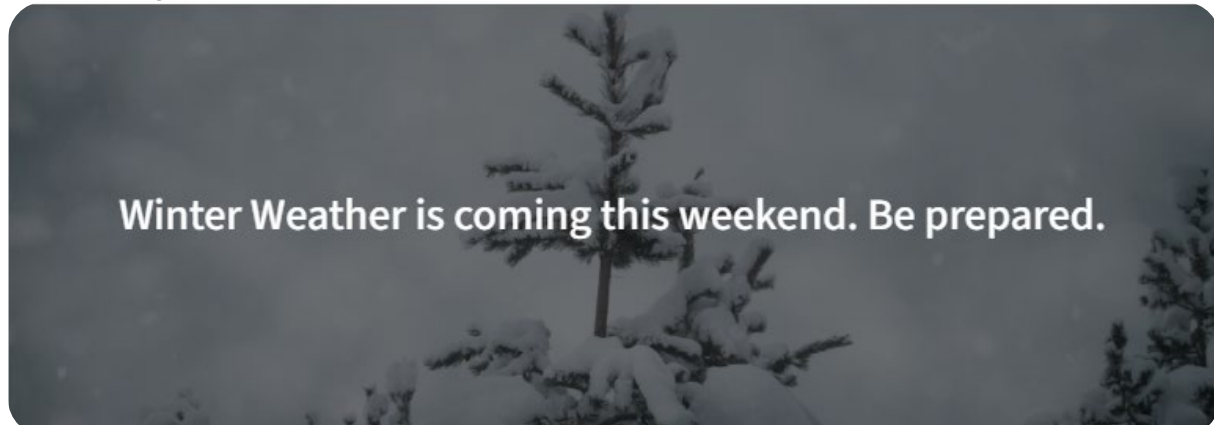
